Membership Application



The New Acquisition Militia Educational Association, Inc. (NAM) is a not-for-profit club registered with the State of South Carolina whose mission is to educate and inform the general public about the Revolutionary War era in the South Carolina Upcountry. The NAM fulfills its mission by supporting national, state, regional, and local parks living history programs in the Carolinas. NAM members also participate in educational outreach programs at schools and civic organizations.

Student Participation: (\$10 annual dues) Students up to age 21 may pay a reduced rate of \$10 per year. Nonadult members under the age of 16 may not participate in any historic weapons demonstration programs or battle reenactments. NAM student members interpret mid to late 18th century life in Colonial America with special emphasis on military history and the collective customs and life experiences of the South Carolina militia. Student members participate in weekend programs re-enacting camp life and educational programs and those 16 and over may participate in some Revolutionary War era battle re-enactments (pending age requirements of the historic site). Student members also take part in parades, ceremonial events, and school programs.

Member Participation: (\$25 annual dues) NAM members interpret mid to late 18th century life in Colonial America with special emphasis on military history and the collective customs and life experiences of the South Carolina militia. Members participate in weekend programs re-enacting camp life and educational programs and some Revolutionary War era battle re-enactments. Members also take part in parades, ceremonial events, and school programs.

Family Participation: (\$40 annual dues) The NAM encourages family participation. It was common for both professional armies and militia units to have "distaff" or camp followers attached to them who were family. "Living History" is a family-oriented hobby. Spouses, children and significant others are encouraged to take part by representing their 18th century counterparts. Clothing, accoutrements and patterns for civilians, which observe the same standards as militia soldiers are available through the same sutlers that supply period military equipment. All persons participating in black powder historic weapons firing demonstrations or battle scenarios MUST be a minimum of 16 years of age.

Clothing, Accoutrements, and Historic Weapons: The militia did not wear uniforms. They were "citizen soldiers" who brought their own clothing, weapons, and other accoutrements. Members acquire their own clothing (e.g. – breeches, waistcoats, shirts, great coats, hats, shoes), accoutrements, (e.g. – haversacks, cartridge boxes, canteens, shot bags), weapons (e.g. – reproduction muskets, rifles, tomahawk, knives, dirks), and period tent or shelter.

Application, Orientation, Membership:

The first step toward membership is completion of this application.

Upon application review, participating in a minimum of three (3) group educational events documented within the membership year (July 1 – June 30) is required. Our educational events provide opportunity for new and seasoned recruits to observe the varied environments in which our members participate, the portrayal and persona of the 18th Century South Carolina upcountry militia we try to recreate, and the clothing, weapons, and accoutrements used. At the discretion of the Board of Directors, the participation provision above may be waived or modified.

A complete kit for a militia persona (e.g. – clothing, accoutrements, and weapons) can easily cost over \$1,000 and this is why the NAM encourages new or prospective members to start with the clothing essentials first.

6. <u>Non-adult</u> members under the age of 16 may not participate in any historic weapons demonstration programs or battle reenactments.
